

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF NEVADA CITY
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO GOOGLE FOR
THE GOOGLE FIBER FOR COMMUNITIES PROGRAM IN NEVADA CITY
AND WESTERN NEVADA COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the City of Nevada City, with the adjacent areas of western Nevada County, is a perfect model rural test site for the deployment of Google Fiber for Communities; and

WHEREAS, Nevada City has a long history of technological firsts; the first long-distance commercial telephone call in the country was made in Western Nevada County during the Gold Rush, and the first telephone network, consisting of five phones, operated here as well, and

WHEREAS, in the 1960's, Nevada City's Grass Valley Group created the technology to display the first graphical special effects on broadcast television; and

WHEREAS, inventors, entrepreneurs, scientists, videographers, artists and the hub of the HD broadcast technology industry make their homes here indicating that we are ideal beta-testers for new consumer and business applications that will take advantage of 1Gbps Internet service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, with the understanding that Google is interested in deploying a fiber network efficiently, effectively and quickly, the City of Nevada City will cooperate fully in this build out by streamlining approvals and guiding Google through the local regulatory processes.
